The position is open to individuals at all stages of their career and all ranks, but candidates must have their Ph.D. by October 2023. Specialization is sought in Public Administration and Policy or Public Management. Sub-expertise in fields such as Technology; Big-Data & Computational Social Sciences; Life Science; Sustainability, Ecology & Environmental Science; Psychology; and Neuroscience are welcome. Evidence of excellence in scholarly publication, research and teaching are required.

Please submit a letter of application, CV, and list of publications. Please provide a research plan, samples of 3 published works and three letters of recommendation.

The [Division of Public Administration & Policy](#) and the [School of Political Sciences](#) at [The Herta and Paul Amir Faculty of Social Sciences, University of Haifa](#) are top ranked centers for the study of political science, public administration & policy, and international relations in Israel. Rank of entry will be decided based on academic qualifications. Final decisions are subject to resource availability, consideration of the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences and the Rector (Provost).
