Specialization is sought in Public Administration and Policy, Technology Policy and Big-Data, Internal Audit in the Public Sector, Strategic Public Management, Political Economics, Policy and law, Comparative Policy Analysis, Environmental and Regional Policy, Urban Policy, or East Asia and Public Policy. Evidence of scholarly publication is required. Candidates with background and specialization in Big Data, Computer Science and Technology relevant to public Administration and Policy are especially welcome to apply.
